MASS IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE

The H1N1 vaccine is now available to the general public within the Labrador-Grenfell Health region. Mass immunization clinics will be held on **Monday, November 23** at the following locations:

- **Labrador City**, Captain William Jackman Memorial Hospital Cafeteria, 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **Happy Valley-Goose Bay**: Community Health Department, Labrador Health Centre, 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- **St. Anthony**: Lion's Club from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.
- **Flower's Cove**: Canon Richards High School from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.
- **Roddickton-Bide Arm**: Gerry Byrne Room, Roddickton arena from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Residents are reminded to bring their MCP card and to wear short sleeves if possible. Children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian in order to sign consent.

Immunizations are also being to individuals in long-term care facilities, personal care homes, those in receipt of continuing care and acute care patients being discharged from hospital.

In addition to mass immunization, Labrador-Grenfell Health will continue with the vaccination of Level I, II and III school students on Monday, November 23, 2009 as follows:
