Funding for New Medical Equipment Announced for Labrador West

Residents in Labrador West will have reduced need to travel outside their community for access to routine echocardiography services, as the Provincial Government is investing \$450,000 for a new ultrasound machine for the Labrador West Health Centre. The Honourable John Haggie, Minister of Health and Community Services, made the announcement today in Labrador City.

"Enhancing access to care is in part about an efficient system and multi-disciplinary care teams, but it is equally about up-todate technology and capital investments. I am pleased to announce this significant investment in a new ultrasound machine for the people of Labrador West."

The new machine has the ability to perform adult echocardiograms, a diagnostic test that was previously unavailable in Labrador West.
