Paramedics with Labrador-Grenfell Health and volunteers will accept all donations and deliver to the Salvation Army for distribution to members of the community who need a helping hand.
- **Roddickton-Bide Arm:** Friday, Dec. 8, 2017, 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Paramedics and partners will accept food and gifts in support of Helping Hands at the Foodland parking lot.
- **Flower's Cove:** Friday, Dec. 8, 2017, 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Volunteers and partners will collect household items, toys, pet items, books and monetary items and distribute to local charities.
- **St. Anthony:** Saturday, Dec. 9, 2017, 10:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Paramedics, nurses, other Labrador-Grenfell Health staff and volunteers participating in the Santa Claus Parade will collect donations for the Food Bank, Christmas toy drive, and pet shelters. Following the parade, an ambulance parked near Tim Horton's, Viking Mall, will also accept household/personal care items, toys/books, pet items, and monetary donations.
- **Happy Valley-Goose Bay:** Saturday, Dec. 16, 2017, 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., Labrador Health Centre. Drop off non-perishable food items for the local Food Bank and unwrapped toys (all ages) for the Emergency Room Nurses' Happy Tree.
