



# Ophthalmic Surgical Microscope

The Grenfell Foundation (South Chapter) is launching a fund-raising campaign to purchase an **Ophthalmic Surgical Microscope** for Charles S. Curtis Memorial Hospital, St. Anthony.

The addition of this equipment will greatly benefit area residents and enable to people to receive services without incurring the expense and delay in travelling to other places for treatment. An **Ophthalmic Surgical Microscope**, valued at \$150,000, is used by ophthalmologists to perform eye surgery.

The Grenfell Foundation is a registered charitable organization created to support the work of Labrador-Grenfell Health. Funds raised are used for capital equipment, research and staff development, relating to the services that Labrador-Grenfell Health provides.

The Grenfell Foundation was established in 2002 to receive funds to be utilized towards the purchase of priority diagnostic medical equipment. The South Chapter of the Grenfell Foundation serves the Northern Peninsula (north of Bartlett's Harbour) and Labrador South.

Through the Grenfell Foundation, individuals, businesses, service clubs, and community organizations can help improve health care services in the region.
