Visitor Restrictions in Effect at the John M. Gray Centre, Level 3, St. Anthony

Due to the presence of influenza-like illness, visitor restrictions are in effect at the John M. Gray Centre, Level 3 in St. Anthony. **The general public is asked to refrain from visiting the long-term care unit until further notice.**

Only those family members who have been designated can visit at this time.

The following precautions are recommended for designated family members at this facility:

- Wash or sanitize your hands thoroughly before entering and leaving this facility.
- Check with nursing staff before visiting the residents' room.
- If you are experiencing any flu-like or gastrointestinal symptoms such as cough, fever, runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea etc.; you should refrain from visiting the Long-Term Care Unit until at least 48 hours after your last symptoms.
- Comply with any other instructions from staff.
