Visitor Restrictions at the Long-Term Care unit in Happy Valley-Goose Bay

(Happy Valley-Goose Bay, NL) Labrador-Grenfell Health is advising the public that visitor restrictions have been lifted at the Long-Term Care Unit, Labrador Health Centre in Happy Valley-Goose Bay; however, restrictions remain in effect in the Protective Care Unit of the facility.

Visitor restrictions were imposed on May 2, 2019 due to the presence of influenza-like illness.

The public is asked not to visit the long-term care unit if they feel ill or are experiencing flulike symptoms. For infection prevention, the public is strongly encouraged to wash their hands frequently, cover their coughs or sneezes with a tissue or the crook of their arms, and refrain from touching their faces.
