Visitor Restrictions in Effect at Long Term Care, Labrador West Health Center

Due to the presence of gastrointestinal-like illness, visitor restrictions are in effect at the Long-Term Care, Labrador West Health Center. **The general public is asked to refrain from visiting the long-term care unit until further notice.**

Only those family members who have been designated, can visit at this time.

The following precautions are recommended for designated family members at this facility:

- Wash or sanitize your hands thoroughly before entering and leaving this facility.
- Check with nursing staff before visiting the residents' room.
- If you are experiencing any flu-like or gastrointestinal symptoms such as cough, fever, runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea etc.; please do not visit the Long-Term Care Unit until at least 48 hours after your last symptoms.
- Comply with any other instructions from staff.
