## Labrador-Grenfell Health is Looking for Vaccine Clinic Volunteers

Labrador-Grenfell Health is engaging the public in search of motivated volunteers looking to be part of the COVID-19 Vaccine Campaign! There are three roles that volunteers can take:

- **Greeters**: the volunteer is responsible for greeting and directing clients to the registration area when they entering the clinic,
- **Post-Immunization Observer**: the volunteer is responsible for watching the area where clients must wait for 15 minutes after their vaccine.
- **Flow Director/Runner**: the volunteer is responsible for directing clients from registration to their vaccine appointment, and from their vaccine appointment to the post-immunization observation area.
