COVID-19 immunizations for priority groups across the Labrador-Grenfell Health region: Appointments available for the clinically extremely vulnerable and individuals 55-59 years of age

Labrador-Grenfell Health is advising the public that COVID-19 vaccination appointments for priority groups continue to be available across the region. In addition to other priority groups currently eligible, the following groups can register beginning April 9, 2021:

- 1. **Individuals (18+) who are clinically extremely vulnerable** These individuals are encouraged to speak with their primary health care provider if they have questions about whether the COVID-19 Vaccine is right for them. - 2. **Individuals 55-59 years of age** These individuals can book an appointment to receive the AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD vaccine.
