Change of Location for Vaccine Clinics in Happy Valley-Goose Bay area July 19 to 23

Labrador-Grenfell Health is advising the public that COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics that had been previously scheduled to take place at the Bethel Pentecostal Tabernacle have been moved to the Happy Valley-Goose Bay Legion.

Public Health has made attempts to contact all individuals who had been given an appointment at the Bethel Pentecostal Tabernacle; however, for those who were unable to be reached, appointments will be honored for the same date and time at the Happy Valley-Goose Bay Legion.

Labrador-Grenfell Health continues to offer walk-in appointments for all first and second COVID-19 Vaccine appointments. Anyone wishing avail of an earlier appointment may do so by walking in at any site or time outlined here-28 days after their first dose.
