# COVID-19 testing continues in Roddickton- Bide Arm with additional pop-up vaccines clinics taking place this week

Labrador-Grenfell Health is advising the public that COVID-19 testing clinics in the Roddickton- Bide Arm area will continue as follows:

Anyone who wishes to receive testing can attend the clinic, even if you are asymptomatic or have even just one symptom.

If you have been contacted by Public Health to get a test, please identify this upon arrival to the clinic.

Individuals who are symptomatic, currently on isolation, or who have been advised by public health that they are a contact should not avail of a vaccine at this time. These individuals are encouraged to check the Labrador-Grenfell Health Vaccine Portal at <a href="https://www.lghealth.ca/vaccine">www.lghealth.ca/vaccine</a> for upcoming vaccine clinics when they complete isolation and are symptom free.

Everyone is reminded to follow public health measures. Residents are encouraged to practice good hand hygiene, wear a mask, stay home when sick and support employees to do the same, and follow provincial public health requirements and recommendations.

Labrador-Grenfell Health continues to provide COVID-19 vaccine clinics across the region and encourage the public to receive their first and second doses. Please visit
