- ✓ Current certification in BCLS (Basic Cardiac Life Support);
- ✓ Breastfeeding education;
- ✓ The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct;
- ✓ Experience with geriatrics is an asset;
- ✓ Class 4 Driver's License or willing to upgrade Experience with geriatrics is an asset.

Duties (Include but not limited to):

- ✓ Providing basic nursing care to residents;
- ✓ Responds to emergency situation and codes;
- ✓ Assist with orientation of new staff;
- Documents according to organizational policies and unit guidelines;
- ✓ Participates in quality assurance/improvement activities;
- ✓ Transports clients and specimens.
