Qualifications:

- Current registration & licensed (or eligible for licensure) as a Nurse Practitioner Family/All ages with the College of Registered
 Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador (CRNNL) are required;
- ✓ Graduate from an approved nurse practitioner education program;
- ✓ Masters of Nursing is an asset;
- ✓ Minimum of five years clinical experience in last seven years of nursing;
- ✓ Current BCLS certification is required;
- ✓ Current ACLS, PALS, TNCC certification or willingness to complete in one year
- ✓ A valid Newfoundland and Labrador Class 5 Drivers license;
- The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct.

<u>Duties:</u> (Included but not limited to)

- Primarily responsible for orphaned patients inclusive of chronic disease management (including CHF and COPD). Provide support to Regional Nurses, PRI
 Clinic.
- Support primary health care (virtually and in person) in multiple locations (incl but not limited to HVGB, Coastal Community Clinics, Health Centers). Will require travel to Health Centers or Community Clinics for 2 weeks every 3 months.
- ✓ Independently and collaboratively assesses, diagnoses and prescribes in accordance with professional, provincial and organizational standards, policies and clinical practice guidelines;
- ✓ Responds to emergency situations and participates in emergency care when required;
- Coordinates treatment plans and follow up based on comprehensive assessments, client and family response and outcomes, collaborating
 with physician if required care is outside of provider's scope of practice and competencies;
- Communicates findings and diagnosis to client and/or inter-professional team. Discusses prognosis, treatment options and outcomes with
 client and/or other team members within the circle of care and documents within the client's permanent health record;
- Advocates for clients, assessing their needs and if applicable, referring to appropriate care providers, professionals or other services in the
 interest of the continuum of care;
