The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) is responsible for maintaining professional and organizational standards and practice in accordance with the LGH Model of Nursing Clinical Practice and reports to the Clinical Nurse Manager.

Qualifications:

- ✓ Graduation from high school or equivalency;
- ✓ Graduation from an approved LPN education program;
- ✓ Current registration with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador (CLPNNL);
- ✓ Breastfeeding course/education;
- ✓ Knowledge of computer skills and an ability to work with Meditech is an asset;
- ✓ Current certification in Basic Life Support (CPR);
- ✓ The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct.

Duties and Responsibilities (include but not limited to):

- ✓ Completes nursing assessment consistent with scope of practice;
- ✓ Participates in the development, revision, implementation and evaluation of nursing care plans;
- ✓ Provide safe, competent and ethical nursing care and make decisions within the LPN scope of practice;
