Duties (Include but not limited to):

- Arranging and conducting clinics for primary care purposes including assessing, diagnosing and prescribing in accordance with professional, provincial and organizational standards, policies and clinical practice guidelines;
- Coordinating treatment plans based on ongoing assessments, client and family response and outcomes, consulting with physician or nurse practitioner if required care is outside of provider's scope of practice and competencies;
- Dispenses medications in accordance with professional, provincial and organizational standards, policies and clinical practice guidelines;
- Coordinating medical follow-up (e.g referrals as appropriate; facilitating transition from hospital to community; and acting as a liaison between the client and various health care providers);
- Consults with the assigned physician and report to the RN II for administrative/management issues;
- Ensuring quality assurance standards are maintained;
- Other duties as assigned (e.g., emergency on-call, documentation of nursing workload measurement system, provide relief in other sites as required; May be required to relieve the RN II;
