Reporting to the Regional Director of Physical Infrastructure Support through the Team Leader located at the Labrador West Health Centre, the primary purpose of this position is to provide sub-professional engineering work on the technical based infrastructure throughout the Labrador West Health Centre

Qualifications:

- ✓ High School Diploma or equivalent;
- ✓ Valid 4th Class Power Engineering certificate to operate and maintain a heating plant and air-conditioning plant in Newfoundland and Labrador;
- ✓ A minimum of two years' experience is preferred;
- ✓ The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct.

Duties and Responsibilities: (Included but not limited to)

- Operates and maintains a heating plant in a safe and orderly manner;
- ✓ Inspects boilers, mechanical, and electrical equipment for proper operation;
- Responsible for necessary repairs to the heating plant system and auxiliary equipment and adjustments to boilers, pumps, and auxiliary equipment including air conditioning and related equipment;
- ✓ Tests boiler water and adds chemicals (use chemicals in accordance with WHMIS regulations);
- Responsible for periodic readings around boiler room and electrical room, completes boiler room log every shift, completes
 appropriate forms as pertaining to the operation of the heating plant;
- ✓ Follows government regulations as put out by the Department of Labour, Boiler Inspection Branch;
- Responsible for general clean up of boiler room, electrical room, and diesel room area;
- ✓ Changes over oxygen cylinders, N2O cylinders, and propane cylinders;
- ✓ Does pipe work throughout the hospital; cleans out radiators, changes filters in sterilizing filtering units in CSR and OR;
- ✓ Carries out fire duties as explained in the fire manual;
- ✓ Performs other related dutues as required.
