Reporting to a Clinical Pharmacist, the primary purpose of this position is to perform technical duties in the Pharmacy Department.

Qualifications:

- ✓ Graduation from high school or equivalent;
- Graduation from a recognized (approved) Pharmacy Technician Program and or successful completion of the Pharmacy Technician Bridging Program;
- Current registration with the Newfoundland and Labrador Pharmacy Board as a Pharmacy Technician;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships in a team environment;
- ✓ Demonstrated strong oral and written communication skills;
- ✓ Demonstrated keyboarding and computer skills;
- ✓ Demonstrated high level of alertness and concentration when performing tasks;
- ✓ Demonstrated effective time management skills and the ability to prioritize;
- A Pharmacy Technician skills test may be administered;
- ✓ A satisfactory record of work performance is required;
- ✓ The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct.

Duties and Responsibilities: (Include but not limited to):

- ✓ Responsible for the technical tasks of pharmacy operations including the preparation, storage and distribution of medication in an institutional pharmacy related to acute care and long term care clients;
- ✓ Duties include dispensing of pharmaceuticals, re-stocking nursing units, filling prescriptions, delivering narcotics, preparation of I.V. solutions, ordering from pharmaceutical companies, compounding and record keeping;

- ✓ Handle and prepare hazardous drugs appropriately including the preparation of intravenous chemotherapy; prepare extemporaneous admixtures;
